

Young European BarCamp: EU'll love it!

Young European BarCamp is an online event for young Europeans. It was invented during the pandemic to give European youth a chance to meet across borders and get an impression of what it is like to live in other countries without getting on a plane. It was a fun format, so we decided to do it once per year.

In 2023, the Young European BarCamp takes place on the 26th of May, from 12:00-16:00 o'clock (CET). Schools, youth groups and individuals across Europe are invited to join. Each partner can register up to 10 persons to participate – free of cost. The working language of the event is English.



What is this BarCamp-thing?

A BarCamp is like a youth-conference, only that there is no ready-made conference program that everyone has to follow. Instead, the event starts with an empty schedule of 45-minute time slots and (virtual) conference rooms in which so called “sessions” will take place. Each group/school joining is asked to prepare content for at least one session.

A session can take the form of a short workshop, a discussion or a creative program. You can show a video clip, call a parliamentarian, host a debate, do a poetry slam! The best sessions are interactive, meaning that the participants are invited to do, play or devise something together – and of course to exchange thoughts and views!

The session proposals are described online in advance. At the event, they are puzzled into the schedule, allowing the participants to put together their individual conference program by choosing the sessions that interest them.
